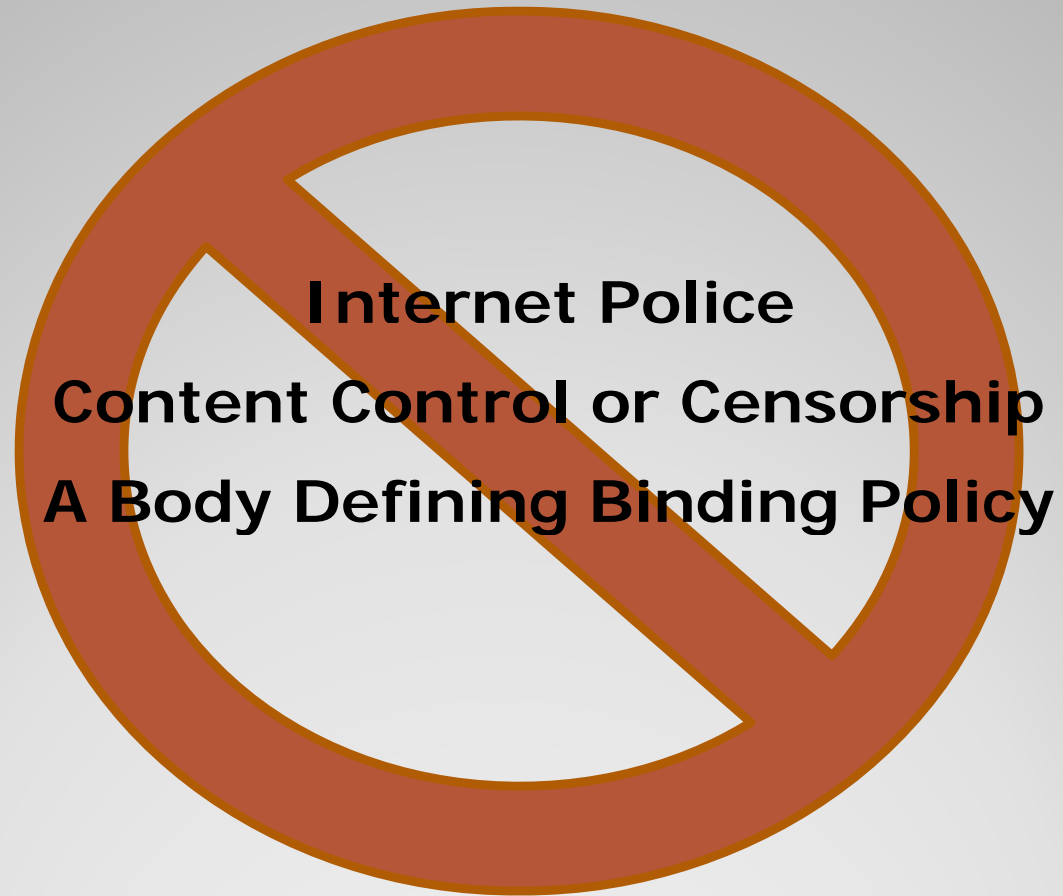
## RISG Members

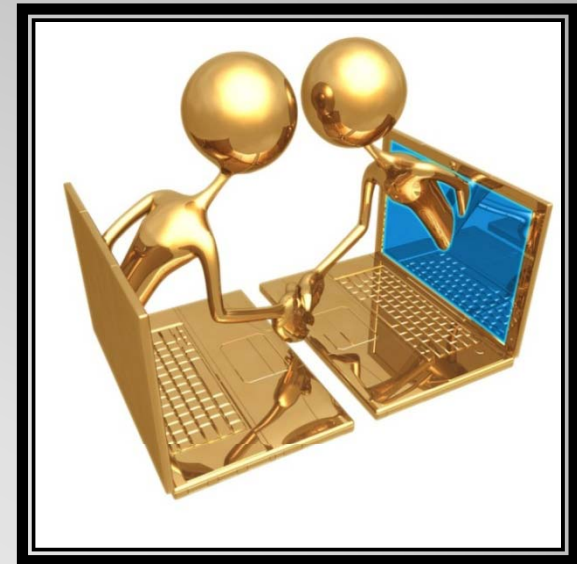

- **Best Practices Data Sharing Plan**
  - Identify curative & preventative goals and associated use cases
  - Identify data relevant to each use case
  - Comply with legal requirements for data sharing
  
- **Anti-Phishing**
  - What types of threats to handle?
  - How to respond to the threats?
  - Identify reliable data indicators of Phishing.
  - How to work with law enforcement?

**What are we doing?**

- Adopt domain suspension at the registry level?
- Positively identify Phishing Sites across TLDs
- Adopt consistent policies across TLDs to minimize domain abuse

  - Particularly ccTLDs
- **Global Law Enforcement Cooperation**
